Tournament Tie-Breaker Format

Welcome to Vision Basketball's Club Tournament in Calgary. The tournament organizing committee wishes you a weekend of fun and rewarding basketball. Please enjoy the many services our community has to offer.

## Tie-Breaker Format:

Several divisions in the tournament have 6 teams - each division is divided into 2 pools of 3 teams each - given this, there is a strong likelihood that all 3 teams could end up with identical 1-1 win-loss records.

Therefore, in the event of a tie the following tie breaking system will be employed:
A) Points For minus points Against with all three teams.
B) If a tie still remains, the calculation becomes points For divided by points Against.

- in the latter, the tie breaker favours a more defensive team (see examples below)

| A) Team A vs. Team B 77-72 | Team A record $=1-1$ | Team A is -5 |
| ---: | :--- | :--- |
| Team A vs. Team C $55-65$ | Team B record $=1-1$ | Team B is +1 |
| Team C vs. Team B | $44-50$ | Team C record $=1-1$ |

Standings: $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}=$ Team C at $+4 ; \mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}=$ Team B at $+1 ; \mathbf{3}^{\text {rd }}=$ Team A at -5
B) Team A vs. Team B 77-70

Team A vs. Team C 54-57
Team C vs. Team B 40-51

Team A record $=1-1$
Team B record $=1-1 \quad$ Team $B$ is +4
Team C record $=1-1 \quad$ Team $C$ is -8

Team A $\quad 131$ divided by $127=1.031$ (lower number with this formula loses tie-breaker)
Team B 121 divided by $117=1.034$ (higher number with this formula wins tie-breaker) Team C $\quad 3^{\text {rd }}$ Place at -8

Standings: $\mathbf{1}^{\text {st }}=$ Team B; $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}=$ Team A; $\mathbf{3}^{\text {rd }}=$ Team C
