TOURNAMENT RULES

## Rules of Play for U11 Boys \& Girls

In keeping with the Long Term Athlete Development model for Basketball, modifications have been made to the FIBA rules specific to each age group and their developmental stages.

## Modified Rules for U11 at Vision Basketball Tournaments

1. Games will be played $4-\mathrm{on}-4$
2. Size 5 Ball
3. 8 ' 6" basket
4. Foul Line -3 feet closer to the basket than the regular foul line
5. Games will be the same length of time as all other VBA Kick Off games - that is, 9 minute stop time quarters with a 5 minute half time
6. Time outs will be the same as all other VBA Kick Off games - two (2) in the first half and two (2) in the second half
7. Substitutions are at the coach's discretion - remember that this is an important developmental stage where every kid needs to play -we will not enforce playing time rules, however, a coach is fully expected to ensure that all kids play relatively equal time - player development by far supersedes the score or outcome of the game
8. Man to Man defense ONLY - no zone defense allowed
9. No intentional double teaming on the ball unless it is near the basket on a drive (in the key) - double teaming at half court or out on the perimeter is not allowed
10. Absolutely no ball screens and no off ball screens - no screens, period
11. No full court press

All other rules will be the same as outlined in the Vision Tournament Rules information. If there is an obvious U11 Rule missing in this outline, please let Mark Hogan know.
